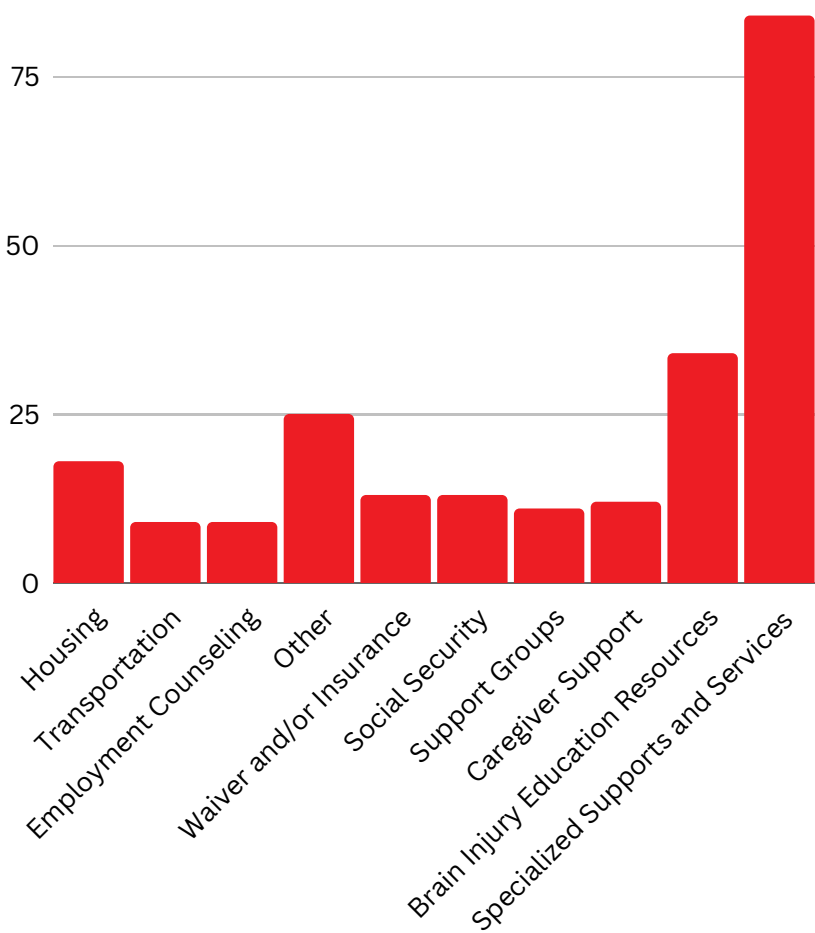

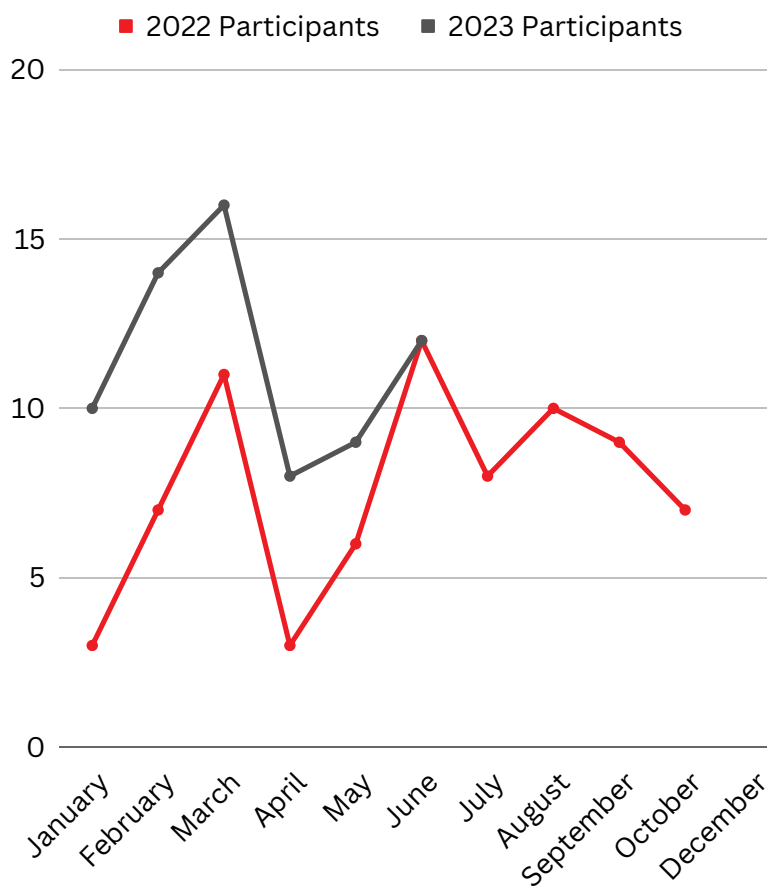


CONCERNS FOR INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES
