

# Do you have Atrial Fibrillation?

Researchers at Ohio State's Richard M. Ross Heart Hospital are conducting several clinical research studies to determine if new treatments for atrial fibrillation are as safe and effective as current treatments. We have many different studies that examine the treatment of atrial fibrillation using drugs, ablation and pacemakers.

You may be eligible to participate in these studies if you:

- Are 18 years or older
- Have a diagnosis of atrial fibrillation
- Have documented episodes of atrial fibrillation over the past 3 months

There are currently several different studies using different methods to treat atrial fibrillation. Participating in an atrial fibrillation study may result in some of your research-related treatment being paid for by the study sponsor. You may be paid for your time while participating. These studies last for different amounts of time, ranging from less than one year up to five years.
