

Do you have Coronary Artery Disease (CAD)?

Researchers at Ohio State's Richard M. Ross Heart Hospital are conducting several clinical research studies to determine if new investigational treatment options for CAD are as safe and effective as current treatments. Our studies examine different aspects of CAD treatment and include a wide range of treatments including drug therapy, angiography and stent placement.

You may be eligible to participate in one of these studies if you:

- Are 18 years or older
- Have CAD
- Are seeking treatment

There are currently several different studies focusing on treatment of CAD. Participating in a CAD study may result in some of your research-related treatment being paid for by the study sponsor. You may be compensated for your time while participating. These studies last for different amounts of time, ranging from one year to five years.
